Manager's Introduction

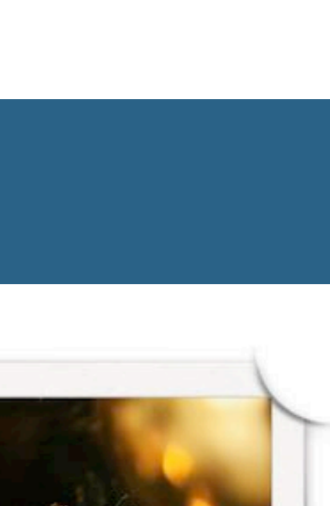

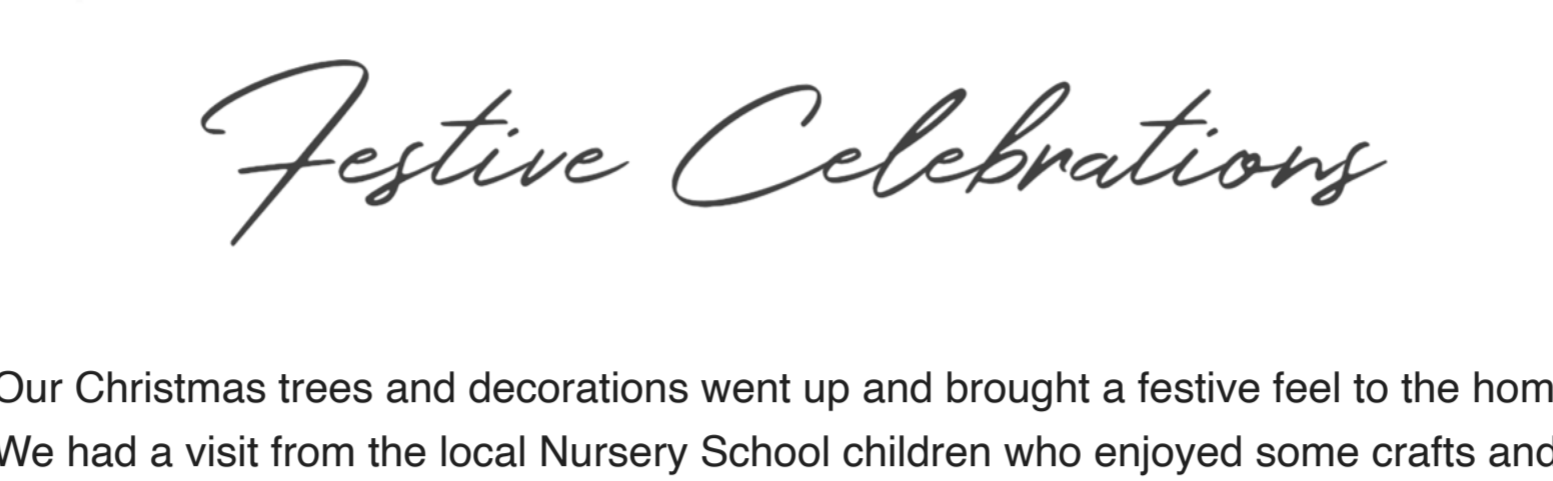

We celebrated our first birthday and the opening of the Home by Deputy Lord Provost Dave Dempsey.

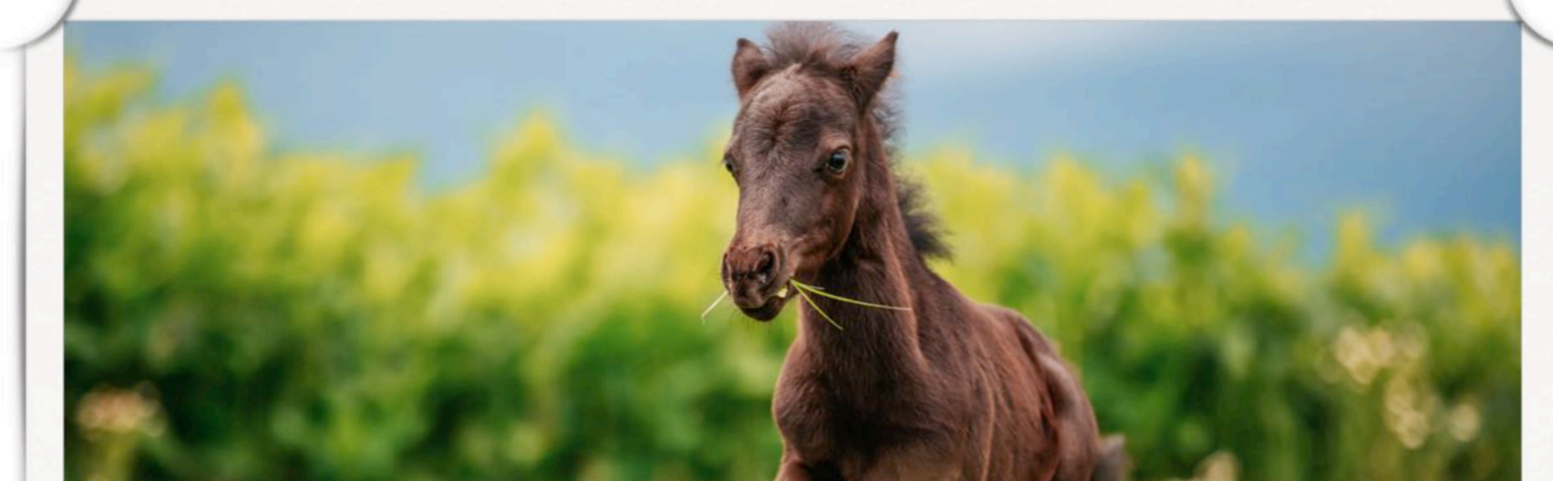
Some of the residents helped decorate the home with banners and balloons.

Tabatha, the Home Manager, presented flowers to Joan who was our first resident when we originally opened one year ago.



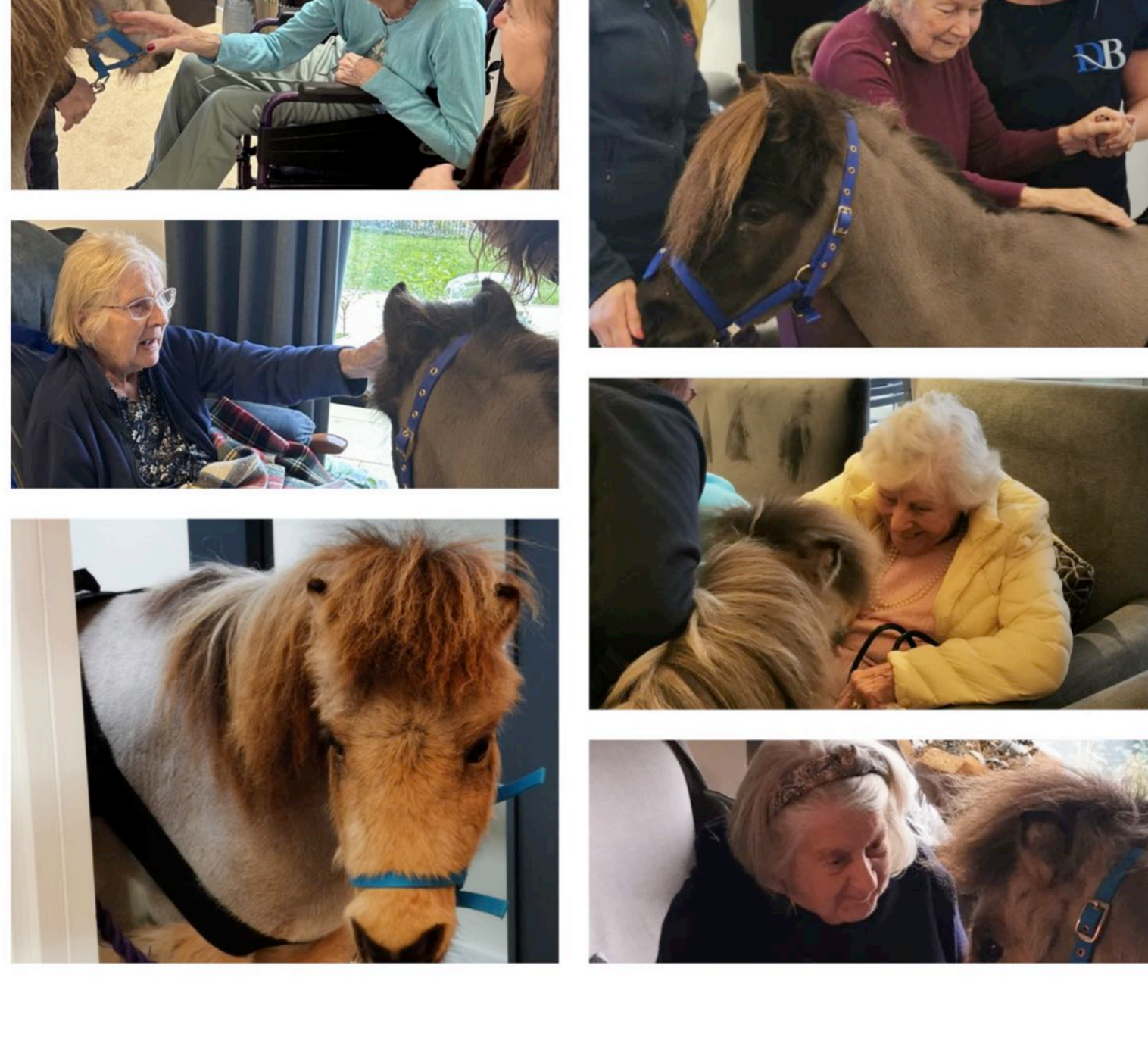
Therapies



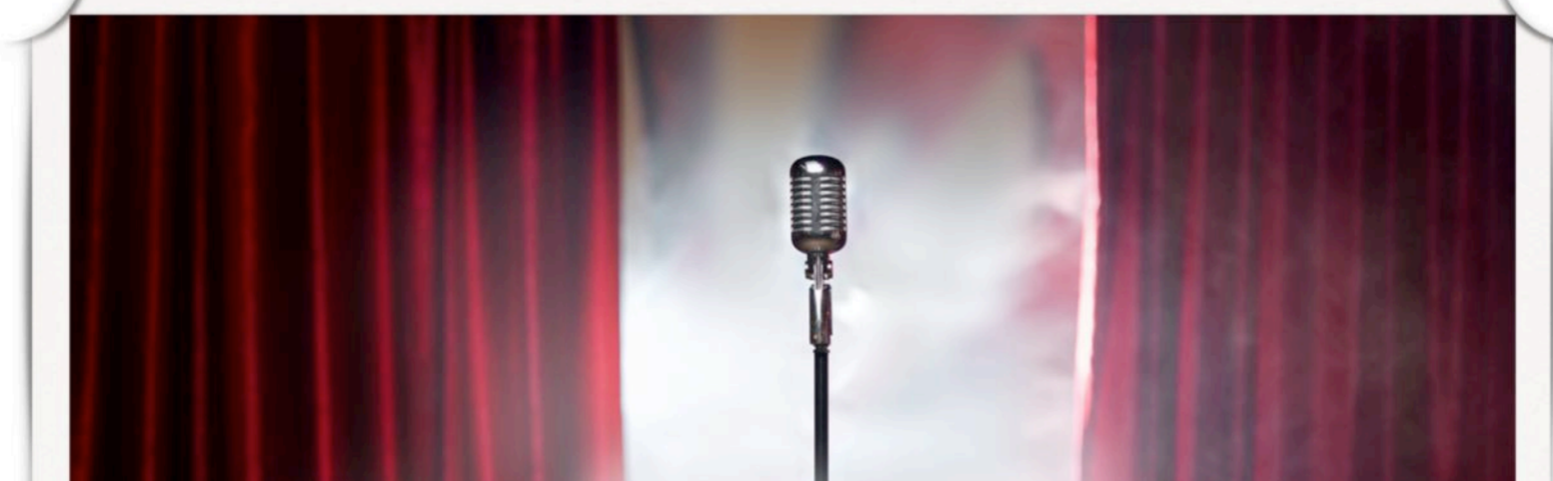
Cuddles & Pats

Good Times

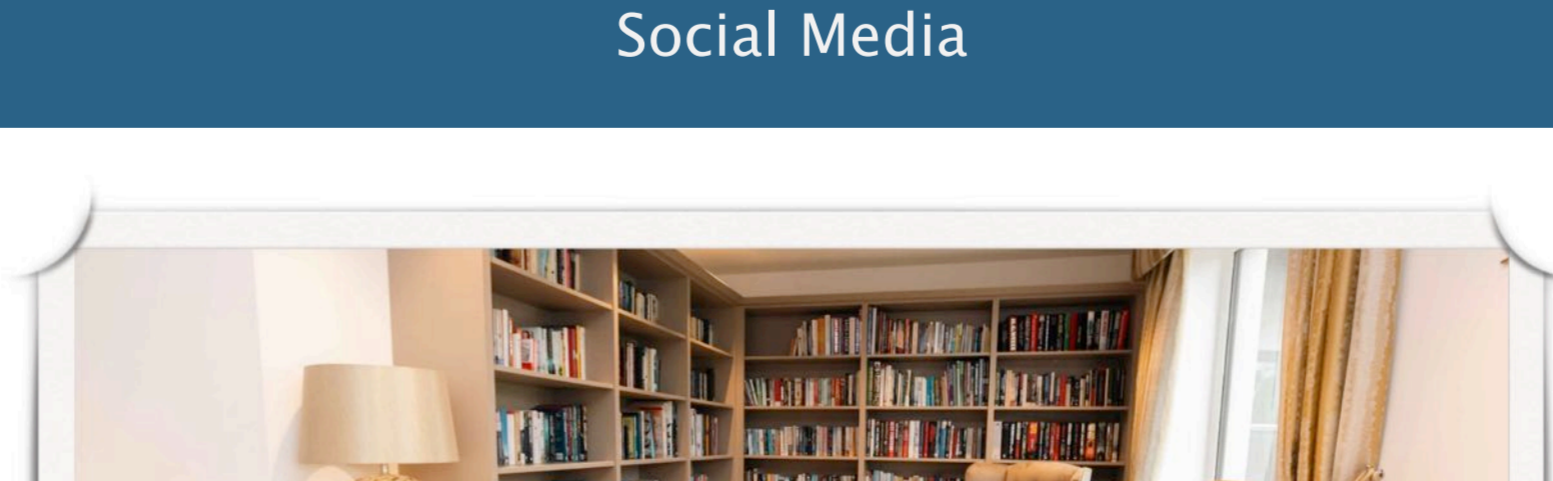

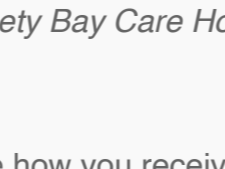
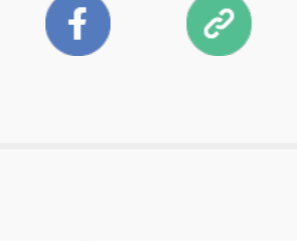
